Highlights


In the first half of 2022, total exports increased 19.2% to US\$246.7 billion compared to the same period last year; total imports over the same period up 24.7% to US\$219.0 billion. The trade balance in the first half of this year was favorable, amounting to US\$27.7 billion.

Major Trading Commodities

Exports

In the first half of 2022, compared with the same period of last year, exports of Parts of Electronic Product, Information, Communication and Audio-video Products, Base Metals and Articles of Base Metal, Plastics & Rubber and Articles Thereof, Machinery, Chemicals, Mineral Products grew by 28.3%, 11.8%, 24.6%, 0.3%, 10.1%, 17.3% and 92.1% respectively; however, exports of Optical, Photographic, Cinematographic Apparatus declined 20.5%.

Imports

In the first half of 2022, compared with the same period of last year, imports of Parts of Electronic Product, Mineral Products, Machinery, Chemicals, Base Metals and Articles of Base Metal, Information, Communication and Audio-video Products, Vehicles, Aircraft, Vessels and Associated Transport Equipment, Plastics & Rubber and Articles Thereof grew by 25.8%, 66.9%, 12.9%, 26.3%, 27.6%, 17.8%, 0.9% and 7.2% respectively.
