# External Trade Report in the First Half of 2024

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# Highlights

In the first half of 2024, total exports increased 11.4% to US\$225.0 billion compared to the same period last year; total imports over the same period up 7.8% to US\$188.9 billion. The trade balance in the first half of this year was favorable, amounting to US\$36.1 billion.

### **Major Trading Commodities**

### Exports

In the first half of 2024, compared with the same period of last year, exports of Information, Communication and Audio-video Products grew up 108.9%. However, exports of Parts of Electronic Product, Base Metals and Articles of Base Metal, Machinery, Plastics & Rubber and Articles Thereof, Chemicals, Mineral Products, Electrical Machinery Products declined 5.6%, 3.9%, 1.6%, 2.8%, 0.5%, 2.1%, and 2.4%, respectively.

#### Imports

In the first half of 2024, compared with the same period of last year, imports of Parts of Electronic Product, Information, Communication and Audio-video Products, Base Metals and Articles of Base Metal, Electrical Machinery Products grew up 25.3%, 35.3%, 13.4%, and 0.3%, respectively; however, imports of Mineral Products, Machinery, Chemicals, Vehicles, Aircraft, Vessels and Associated Transport Equipment declined 5.6%, 21.1%, 0.6%, and 1.0%, respectively.

# **Major Trading Partners**

### Exports

In the first half of 2024, compared with the same period of last year, exports to ASEAN as well as the U.S.A. grew by 22.6% and 60.5%, respectively. However, exports to Mainland China & Hong Kong, Japan, and Europe declined 2.2%, 21.6%, and 4.4%, respectively.

# Imports

In the first half of 2024, compared with the same period of last year, imports from Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, and the U.S.A. grew by 14.1%, 14.2%, and 27.0%, respectively. However, imports from Japan, Europe, and the Middle East declined 3.7%, 8.8%, and 6.8%, respectively.
