Highlights


For Mar. 2021, total exports expanded 27.1% year on year to US\$ 35.89 billion; total imports rose by 27.0% from a year earlier to US\$ 32.23 billion. The trade balance of this month was favorable, amounting to US\$ 3.66 billion.

Major Trading Commodities

Exports

In Mar. 2021, compared with the same month of last year, exports of parts of electronic product, information, communication and audio-video products, base metals and articles of base metal, plastics & rubber and articles thereof, machinery grew by 24.5%, 38.9%, 21.4%, 39.0%, and 29.3%, respectively.

Imports

In Mar. 2021, compared with the same month of last year, imports of parts of electronic product, mineral products, machinery, chemicals, base metals and articles of base metal grew by 33.2%, 28.4%, 37.8%, 17.7%, and 25.8%, respectively.

Exports

In Mar. 2021, compared with the same month of last year, exports to Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, the U.S.A., and Europe grew by 35.5%, 24.0%, 34.7%, and 17.4%, respectively. However, exports to Japan declined 0.3%

Imports

In Mar. 2021, compared with the same month of last year, imports from Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, Japan, Europe, and the Middle East grew by 23.8%, 26.6%, 24.1%, 34.6%, and 47.0%, respectively. However, imports from the U.S.A. declined 2.3%.
