Highlights


For July 2024, total exports expanded 3.1% year on year to US\$ 39.94 billion; total imports rose by 16.2% from a year earlier to US\$ 35.10 billion. The trade balance of this month was favorable, amounting to US\$ 4.83 billion.

Major Trading Commodities

Exports

In July 2024, compared with the same month of last year, exports of information, communication and audio-video products grew by 42.4%. However, exports of parts of electronic product, base metals and articles of base metal, machinery, plastics & rubber and articles thereof declined 12.0%, 5.9%, 5.6%, and 4.5%, respectively.

Imports

In July 2024, compared with the same month of last year, imports of parts of electronic product, mineral products, information, communication and audio-video products, base metals and articles of base metal grew by 28.4%, 10.4%, 73.7%, and 37.8%, respectively. However, imports of machinery declined 3.1%.

Exports

In July 2024, compared with the same month of last year, exports to the U.S.A. grew by 70.3%. However, exports to Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, Japan, and Europe declined 13.5%, 0.4%, 15.9%, and 33.7%, respectively.

Imports

In July 2024, compared with the same month of last year, imports from Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, Japan, the U.S.A., and the Middle East grew by 22.1%, 26.2%, 9.7%, 5.1%, and 0.9%, respectively. However, imports from Europe declined 12.4%.
