Highlights


For Feb. 2026, total exports expanded by 20.6% year on year to US\$49.80 billion; total imports rose by 6.8% from a year earlier to US\$37.03 billion. The trade balance of this month was favorable, amounting to US\$12.77 billion.

Major Trading Commodities

● Exports

In Feb. 2026, compared with the same month of last year, exports of information, communication and audio-video products, parts of electronic product, machinery grew by 38.7%, 24.6%, and 10.0%, respectively. However, exports of base metals and articles of base metal as well as chemicals declined by 4.7% and 5.9%, respectively.

● Imports

In Feb. 2026, compared with the same month of last year, imports of parts of electronic product, information, communication and audio-video products, machinery grew by 24.0%, 81.9%, and 0.2%, respectively. However, imports of mineral products as well as chemicals declined by 30.2% and 18.3%, respectively.

In Feb. 2026, compared with the same month of last year, exports to the U.S.A., Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, Europe, Japan, and Korea grew by 33.7%, 3.3%, 32.2%, 29.0%, 20.4%, and 14.8%, respectively.

● Imports

In Feb. 2026, compared with the same month of last year, imports from Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, and Korea grew by 20.7%, 27.5%, and 14.7%, respectively. However, imports from Japan, the U.S.A., and Europe declined by 8.0%, 7.5%, and 14.4%, respectively.
