Highlights

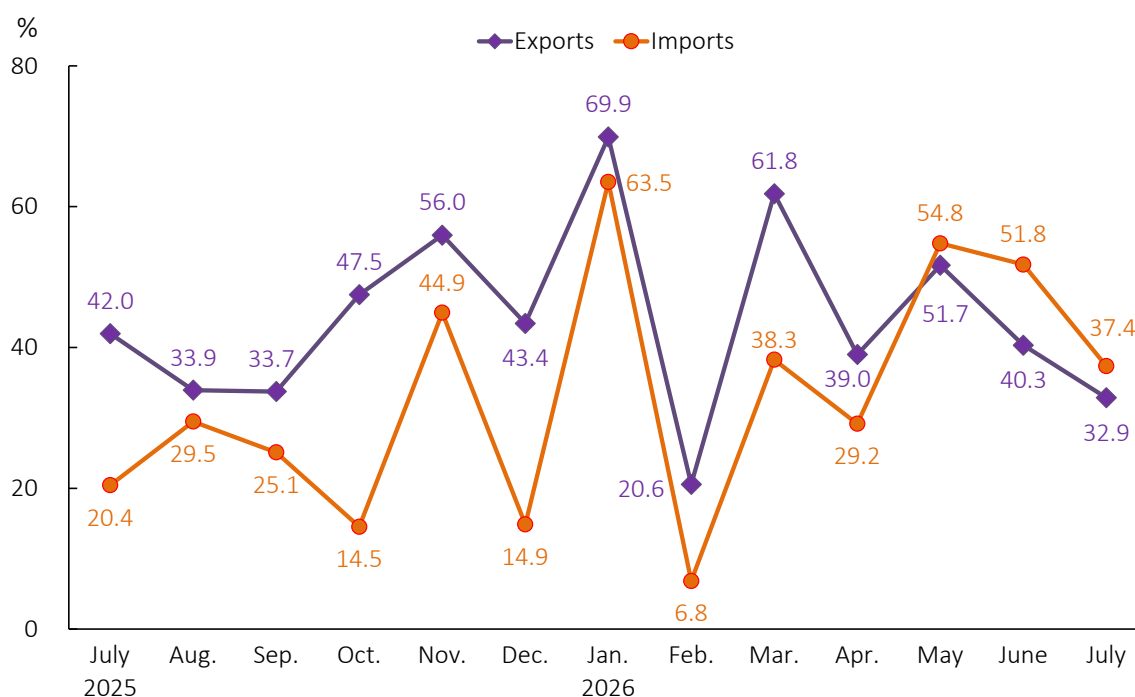
For July 2026, total exports expanded by 32.9% year on year to US\$75.30 billion; total imports rose by 37.4% from a year earlier to US\$58.13 billion. The trade balance of this month was favorable, amounting to US\$17.17 billion.

Major Trading Commodities

● Exports

In July 2026, compared with the same month of last year, exports of information, communication and audio-video products, parts of electronic product, base metals and articles of base metal, machinery, and electrical machinery products grew by 29.5%, 50.5%, 24.8%, 10.8%, and 34.3%, respectively.

In July 2026, compared with the same month of last year, imports of parts of electronic product, information, communication and audio-video products, mineral products, machinery, and chemicals grew by 61.5%, 68.6%, 25.9%, 33.8%, and 6.2%, respectively.

In July 2026, compared with the same month of last year, exports to the U.S.A., Mainland China & Hong Kong, ASEAN, Europe, Japan, and Korea grew by 25.2%, 33.4%, 16.8%, 57.6%, 41.4%, and 50.8%, respectively.
